Whereas, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure 5005(a)(2), 9029, and 9036 authorize bankruptcy courts to establish practices and procedures for the filing, signing, maintaining, and verifying of pleadings and papers by electronic means;

Whereas, on January 12, 2006, the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern and Western Districts of Arkansas ("the Court") adopted Revisions to the Court's Local Rules (the "Revisions");

Whereas, those Revisions included Local Rule 5005-4 entitled "Electronic Filing";

Whereas, Local Rule 5005-4 now encompasses matters previously addressed by General Order 19 and General Order 23;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby

ORDERED that General Order 19, adopted December 17, 2001, and General Order 23, adopted October 23, 2002, are **REVOKED**. It is further

ORDERED that the Court's *Administrative Procedures for Electronically Filed Cases and Related Documents* ("the Administrative Procedures") may require occasional revisions, which will be made as necessary with the approval of the Court. It is further

ORDERED that the most current version of the Administrative Procedures shall be separately posted from the General Orders on the Court's publically accessible website.
